SYLLABUS IN BRIEF:

ENGLISH

- Writing small cursive letters a-z and capital cursive letters A-Z
- Identification of two letter, three letter words basing on vowel sound and learning the spellings.
- Reading 4-5-6 letter words and simple sentences.
- Picture talk, story telling and few rhymes.
- Use of a/an, singular and plural (s/es)
- Simple phrases with opposites and pairs of words.
- Use of this – that, these, those, is – are in sentences
- Use of in, on, under, behind, in between in sentences.
- Naming words, action words, and describing words.

ENGLISH

- Sight reading of the words with sound 'a' from the book pages(1-12)
- Writing small cursive letters (a-z)
- Writing capital cursive letters (A-Z)

- Activity with flash cards.
- Short poems with phonic sound. Eg. : bat, mat, cat, who is in the hat ?
It is a fat rat, why don't you give it a pat ?
