## **ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT**

### **Parent to note the following:**

*(Common to all classes)*

- a. *A student must secure a grade not less than 'C' in Project Work/Oral Test/Internal Assessment in Scholastic and Co-Curricular Activities for Nursery to Class V and minimum grade 'D' for Class VI and above in Scholastic and Co-Scholastic areas.*
- b. *Students appearing the **Improvement Test** will come to school only after getting the results of the Improvement Test. Their attendance for the next session will be counted from the day after the declaration of results of the Improvement Test.*
- c. *A student has to put in a minimum of 75% attendance. The attendance will be counted from the first day of the new academic session.*
- d. *No leave will be sanctioned if information is received by school after taking leave.*
- e. *In case of illness, medical certificate of sickness and subsequently fitness certificate issued by NALCO doctor(s) alongwith photocopy of the relevant page of the medical card or RMPs only will be accepted.*

### **Note:**

*No re-examination will be conducted for students until and unless they have been deputed to participate in inter-school/zonal/district/national sports or any such activity. These students will be considered for the academic awards.*

## **NURSERY TO CLASS V**

### **I. Scholastic Subjects-Part-1(Main)**

- a) *Nursery to Class V will have three Evaluations : Evaluation-1 (April to August), Evaluation-2 (September to December) and Evaluation-3 (January to March) in an Academic Session. Each Evaluation has 50 as the maximum marks.*
- b) *Each Evaluation will have one Formative and one Summative Assessment.*
- c) *Each Formative Assessment will have one round of RAT of 20marks of 45 minutes duration and two activities of 10 marks each under CCE pattern.*



- d) *Each Summative Assessment will have 40 as maximum marks and will be of 1 hour 30 minutes duration.*
- e) *For Final Assessment, equal weightage will be given to all the three Evaluations.*
- f) *Assessment of subjects under Scholastic Area shall be in numerical scores upto two decimal places (i.e. 18.58 ; 9.36 etc.) to be converted to Grades on a five-point scale which shall be indicated in the Grade Statement of Subject -wise Performance/Certificate of Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation. Marks secured by the students will be rounded off only at the end of the Final Assessment. However for any award calculation, rounding off of marks will not be considered.*
- g) *The students will be assessed in subjects under Scholastic Area-A using the conventional numerical marking and later converted into grades.*
- h) *Result will be declared on the basis of Final Assessment only. The qualifying grade in each subject under Scholastic Area-A shall be minimum Grade C. In case a student secures Grade D in any of the subjects in Final Assessment, he/she has to improve the performance in the Improvement Test in such a way that grade in the Final Assessment in that subject(s) becomes C.*

## **II. Scholastic Subject Part-I ( Internal)**

- a) *Two activities of 5 marks each in 3<sup>rd</sup> Language will be conducted before each Evaluation.*
- b) *Written Test of 40 marks in 3<sup>rd</sup> Language and General Knowledge of 25 marks of 45 minutes duration will be held before each Evaluation.*
- c) *Skill, Aptitude and Written Test will be conducted in Computer Science before each Evaluation for class IV & V. Skill, Aptitude and Class Work will be evaluated in Computer Science before each Evaluation for class I,II & III. A student must secure minimum C Grade in Computer Science.*
- d) *A student must secure a minimum of C Grade for classes II to V in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Language, General Knowledge and Computer Science. The student who secures less than C Grade in any of these subjects has to improve the performance by securing the minimum qualifying Grade-C.*

### **III. Co-curricular Activities- Part-2**

- a) *Assessment in Co-curricular Activities (Games, Art/Craft, Music/Dance and Personality Development & Health) will be carried out before each Evaluation.*
- b) *Assessment in these subjects shall also be in grades, as per Scheme of Studies.*

**NOTE:** *At the end of the academic session, CCE Achievement Record will be issued to each student.*

### **Classes VI to VIII**

#### **I. Scholastic Subjects-Part-1 (Main)**

- a) *Classes VI to VIII will have two Terms in an Academic Session: Term-I (April to September) and Term-II (October to March).*
- b) *1st Term will have two Formative Assessments and one Summative Assessment and 2<sup>nd</sup> Term will have one Formative, one PSA and One Summative Assessment.*
- c) *Each Formative Assessment will have one round of RAT having 20 marks of 1 hour duration and two activities of 10 marks each under CCE pattern. PSA will have 60 marks MCQ Test (12 marks from each Scholastic Main Subject) of 90 minutes duration. There is no specific Syllabus / special preparation required for PSA. The average of the score secured by the child will be reflected in all main subjects in FA-4 irrespective of the score secured in different subjects in the PSA.*
- d) *Each Summative Assessment will have a maximum of 80 marks and will be of 2 hours and 30 minutes duration for classes VI to VIII.*
- e) *For Final Assessment, weightage distribution is 40% (all FAs & PSA), 30% (SA1) and 30% (SA2).*
- f) *Assessment of subject(s) under Part -1(Scholastic Area) shall be in numerical scores upto two decimal places (i.e. 18.54 ; 9.39 etc.) to be converted to Grades on a nine-point scale which shall be indicated in the Grade Statement of Subject-wise Performance/Certificate of Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation. Marks secured by the students will be rounded off only at the end of Final Assessment. However for any award calculation rounding off of marks will not be considered.*

- g) *The students will be assessed in subjects under Part -1(Scholastic Area) using the conventional numerical marking and later converted into the grades as per the CBSE grading pattern.*
- h) *Result will be declared on the basis of Final Assessment only. In case a student secures below Grade D in **any of the subjects**, he/she has to improve the performance through Improvement Test. The marks secured in the Improvement Test should be such that the Final Assessment grade in the subject(s) is Grade D.*

## **II. Scholastic Subject Part-1(Internal)**

- a) *Two activities of 5 marks each in 3<sup>rd</sup> Language and Practical of 10 marks in Computer Science will be conducted before each Summative Assessment.*
- b) *Written Test of 40 marks in 3<sup>rd</sup> Language & Computer Science and General Knowledge of 50 marks of 1 hour 30 minutes duration will be conducted before each Summative Assessment.*
- c) *A student must secure a minimum of grade D in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Language, Computer Science and General Knowledge. The student who secures less than grade D in any of these subjects has to appear for an Improvement Test.*
- d) *Those students who could not clear the 3<sup>rd</sup> Language in class VIII, and have been promoted to class IX shall be examined at the end of Class IX in the same syllabus and text books prescribed for Class VIII.*

## **III.Co-Scholastic SubjectsPart 2 &3: 2(A), 2(B), 2(C), 2(D), 3(A) & 3(B)**

- a) *Assessment in Co- Scholastic subjects :2(A) Life Skills, 2(B) Work Education, 2(C) Visual and Performing Arts, 2(D) Attitudes and Values, 3(A) Co-scholastic Activities & 3(B) Health and Physical Education will be evaluated under CCE.*
- b) *Assessment in subjects under Co-scholastic Areas shall be assessed on a 5 point scale once in an academic session.*

### **NOTE:**

- *The qualifying grade in each subject under Scholastic Area (Part -1) and subjects under Co-scholastic areas(Part-2 & 3)shall be minimum Grade D in Final assessment/ Improvement Test as mentioned above.*
- *At the end of the academic session, CCE Report Book will be issued to each student.*

## **Class IX & X**

### **I. Scholastic Subjects Part – I (Main)**

- a) Classes IX & X will have two Terms in an Academic Session: Term-I (April to September) and Term-II (October to March).
- b) 1st Term will have two Formative Assessments and one Summative Assessment and 2<sup>nd</sup> Term will have one Formative, one PSA and One Summative Assessment.
- c) Each Formative Assessment will have one round of RAT having 20 marks of 1 hour duration and two activities of 20 marks each **(out of the two activities, the best score secured by the student will be added to RAT score)** under CCE pattern. The student has to appear both the activities in each subject. PSA will have 60 marks MCQ Test (10% weightage will be given to English, Maths, Science & Social Sc. scholastic main Subjects) of 90 minutes duration. There is no specific syllabus / special preparation required for PSA. However there is no PSA for 2<sup>nd</sup> Language. Therefore Formative Test-IV will be conducted for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Language (Hindi/Sanskrit)
- d) Each Summative Assessment will have a maximum of 90 marks and will be of three hours duration for classes IX & X.
- e) It is mandatory for a student to appear and secure minimum grade D in all the assessments during the academic session.
- f) For Final Assessment, weightage distribution is 40% (all FAs & PSA), 30% (SA1) and 30% (SA2).
- g) Assessment of subjects under Scholastic Area A shall be in numerical scores upto two decimal places ( i.e. 18.56 ; 9.38 etc.) to be converted to Grades on a nine-point scale which shall be indicated in the Grade Statement of Subject-wise Performance/Certificate of Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation. Marks secured by the students will be rounded off only at the end of Final Assessment.
- h) The students will be assessed in subjects under Scholastic Area A using the conventional numerical marking and later converted into the grades and the same shall be awarded as per the CBSE grading pattern.
- i) Result will be declared on the basis of Final Assessment only. A student obtaining E1 or E2 in any or all the five subjects under Scholastic Part-1 in the Final Assessment shall be eligible for improvement of performance in any or all the five subjects in only one chance. In case a student secure less than D grade in any of the five subjects, then he/she will be asked to repeat in the same class.

- j) *The marks secured in the Improvement Test should be such that the Final Assessment grade in the subject(s) is Grade D.*
- k) *It is mandatory for students to appear in both the Summative Assessments and score a minimum of 25% marks in each subject (SA-I + SA-II). If the student does not obtain 25% marks in subject(s) then he/she will be eligible for improvement of performance.*
- l) *The grades 'E1@' or 'E2@' will indicate that the candidate has obtained less than 25% mandatory marks in Summative Assessments.*
- m) *The grade scored in the Assessment of Speaking and Listening Skills (ASL) in English will be a part of Summative Assessments I and II: 70 marks(written) and 20marks (ASL). This will be reflected as an aggregate grade in the Performance Profile.*
- n) *As Open Text Based Assessment (OTBA) will be a part of the Summative Assessment-II question paper of Class IX only, there will be no need for calculating grades in the subjects containing OTBA separately.*
- o) *The total marks of the question papers for the subjects having OTBA (English, Hindi, Mathematics, Science and Social Science) in the Summative Assessment II will be 90 and the timing will be 3-3½ hours. The overall marks obtained in these subjects will be divided by 3 to make it 30% which is the weightage for Summative Assessments II. For the subjects which do not have OTBA element, the question paper will be of 90 marks and the process for computing 30% weightage is same, i.e. divided by 3 to make it 30%.*
- p) *If the mandatory 25% marks have NOT been obtained in the Summative Assessments in a subject, Grade E1 will NOT be upgraded. Grade E<sub>2</sub> will not be upgraded in any subject.*

## **II. Scholastic Subjects Part-1(Internal)**

- a) *Practical of 10 marks in Information Technology will be conducted before each Summative Assessment.*
- b) *Written Test of 40 marks in Information Technology of 1 hour 30 minutes duration will be held before each Summative Assessment.*
- c) *A student must secure a minimum of grade D in Information Technology. The student who secures less than grade D in any of the subject has to appear for an Improvement Test. The grade will be reflected in ICT evaluated under Co-scholastic Area.*

## **III. Co-Scholastic Subjects Part2&3:2(A),2(B),2(C),2(D),3(A) & 3(B)**

*Assessment in Co- Scholastic subjects 2(A) Life Skills, 2(B) Work Education, 2(C) Visual and Performing Arts, 2(D) Attitudes and Values, 3(A) Co*

*Scholastic Activities & 3(B)Health and Physical Education will be evaluated under CCE*

- a) *Assessment in subjects under Co-Scholastic Areas shall be assessed on a 5 point scale before each FA & SA in an academic session.*

**NOTE:**

- *The qualifying grade in all the five subjects under Scholastic Area (Part -1) and subjects under Co-scholastic areas(Part-2&3)shall be minimum Grade D in Final assessment/ Improvement Test as mentioned above.*
- *At the end of the academic session, CCE Report Book will be shown to each student of class IX and consolidated Performance Profile will be issued to each student by CBSE at the end of the academic session(Class-X).*

**Class XI**

**I. Scholastic Subjects Part-1(Main)**

- a) *Class XI will have two Formative Assessments, one PSA, one Half-Yearly and Annual Examination in an academic session.*
- b) *All promotions will be based on performance in Formative Assessments, Half-Yearly and Annual Examination.*
- c) *For Final Assessment, weightage distribution is 40% (all FAs & Half-Yearly) and 60% (Annual Examination).*
- d) *To be declared pass, a student should secure minimum of 33% in each subject. In subjects involving Practical, the student has to secure a minimum of 33% in theory(Final Assessment) and practical(Annual) separately in addition to 33% in aggregate in Final Assessment.*
- e) *In case a student has secured less than 33% in any one subject, he/she will have to appear for Compartmental Examination( only one chance) in the subject.*
- f) *There will be no Compartmental Examination in Practical.*
- g) *A student should secure a minimum of 33% in the subject in which he/she has appeared the Compartmental Examination. Only then he/she will be declared pass/eligible for the next higher class.*
- h) *If the student is not able to score the minimum pass mark even after compartmental examination, then he/she will not be eligible for the next higher class and will be asked to repeat in the same class.*
- i) *Separate certificate will be issued by the Board for PSA Examination.*

- j) *Open Text Based Assessment (OTBA) will be a part of the Annual Examination question papers of Biology and Economics subjects only for Class XI.*

## **II. Scholastic Subject Part-1(Internal)**

*Assessment in General Studies will be conducted before Half-Yearly and Annual Examination. Evaluation will be done on 9 point scale as per CBSE.*

## **III. Co-Scholastic Subjects**

*Assessment in Co- Scholastic subjects - Work Experience and Physical & Health Education will be conducted before Half-Yearly and Annual Examination. Evaluation will be done on 9 point grading scale as per CBSE.*

### **Class IX to XII**

*Note : Promotion criteria for classes IX, X , XI and XII will be as per CBSE specifications. They may change from time-to-time as and when CBSE amends the Examination By-Law.*

## **ACADEMIC AWARDS**

### **CLASSES I To V**

#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. The Academic Awards shall be declared for classes I to V on the basis of Final Assessment only. Here, the actual marks (without rounding off) scored by the child will be taken into account for deciding merit. For example a student securing 89.73% or 89.99% will be marked as Grade A.*
- 2. To be eligible for any Academic Award, a student has to appear in all the Formative Assessments(Written and Activity) and Summative Assessment under each Evaluation.*
- 3. A student should secure a minimum of A\* grade in Scholastic Subjects and 75 points in total in Co- Curricular Activities and Personality Development in each Evaluation.*
- 4. A student should put in a minimum of 75% attendance.*
- 5. The academic awards will be declared taking all the sections of a class together.*

#### **GENERAL PROFICIENCY I, II AND III**

- 1. The student who secures the highest aggregate will be declared as General Proficiency-I; the student who secures the second highest aggregate will be declared as General Proficiency-II and a student*

*who secures the third highest aggregate will be declared as General Proficiency-III.*

- 2. To be eligible for General Proficiency, the student should have secured a minimum of A\* grade in all scholastic-Part-1 main subjects.*
- 3. If two students secure General Proficiency-I then, the General Proficiency-III will not be declared. If three students secure General Proficiency-I then, there will be no General Proficiency-II and III.*

### **SUBJECT PROFICIENCY**

*Subject Proficiency I and II will be awarded only if the student secures the highest / second highest marks (in all sections) and a minimum of A\* grade in the respective subject and B grade in all other Scholastic Part-1 (Main Subjects). If two students qualify for Subject Proficiency-I then, there will no Subject Proficiency-II award.*

### **CLASSES VI TO IX AND XI**

#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- 1. The Academic Awards shall be declared for classes VI to IX and XI on the basis of Final Assessment only. Here, the actual marks (without rounding off) scored by the child will be taken into account. For example a student securing 90.43 or 90.99 in classes VI to IX & XI will be marked as A2*
- 2. To be eligible for any academic award, a student has to appear in all the Formative Assessments( Written & Activities) / Summative Assessments / Half-Yearly / Annual Exam.*
- 3. A student should secure a minimum of A1 grade in Scholastic subjects, minimum of 53 points for classes VI to IX and B2 in Co-Scholastic subjects for class XI.*
- 4. A student should put in a minimum of 75% attendance.*
- 5. The academic awards will be declared taking all the sections of a class together.*
- 6. However General Proficiency-II will be declared only in those classes which have a strength of more than 40 students. General Proficiency-III will be declared only in those classes which have a strength more than 80 students.*
- 7. The scores of a student appearing the Improvement Test will not be considered for any Academic Award.*



### **GENERAL PROFICIENCY I, II AND III**

1. *The student who secures the highest aggregate will be declared as General Proficiency-I; the student who secures the second highest aggregate will be declared as General Proficiency-II and the student who secures the third highest aggregate will be declared as General Proficiency-III.*
2. *To be eligible for General Proficiency, the student should have secured a minimum of A1 grade in all Scholastic-Part-1 main subjects for classes VI to IX and XI.*
3. *For class XI, in subjects which are common to XI Science and XI Commerce awards will be given considering both the sections together and for other subjects, awards will be given separately.*
4. *General Proficiency Awards for class XI Science and XI Commerce will be declared separately subjected to the condition that the student's achievement satisfies all other conditions.*
5. *If two students secure General Proficiency-I then, the General Proficiency-III will not be declared. If three students secure General Proficiency-I then, there will be no General Proficiency-II and III.*

### **SUBJECT PROFICIENCY**

1. *Subject Proficiency I and II will be awarded only if the student secures the highest / second highest marks (in all sections) and a minimum of 'A1' grade in the respective subject and 'C2' grade in all other scholastic Part-1 (Main) subjects.*
2. *Subject Proficiency (2<sup>nd</sup> Language) in Hindi and Sanskrit will be declared separately. Subject Proficiency (3<sup>rd</sup> Language) in Hindi, Odia and Sanskrit will be declared separately.*
3. *Subject Proficiency II will be declared only in those classes which have more than 80 students.*
4. *If two students qualify for Subject Proficiency-I, then there will be no Subject Proficiency-II award.*
5. *Subject Proficiency in Computer Science will be declared from Class IV to IX. Subject Proficiency in GK will be declared from class IV to class VIII.*

## **SCHOLAR BADGE**

*A child is declared Scholar from Class IV onwards and a Scholar Badge is given to a student securing certain number of points as per the grading pattern.*

### **Classes IV & V**

*A student should secure a minimum of 25 points in total in the Scholastic Subjects part-1 (Main), with minimum of 'A' grade in each of the Scholastic Subjects part-1 (Internal) and minimum of 75 points in Co-Scholastic areas in each Evaluation.*

### **Classes VI to IX & XI**

*A student should secure a minimum of 49 points in total in the Scholastic part-1 (Main Subjects), with minimum of 'A2' grade in each of the Scholastic Subjects part-1 (Internal) and minimum of 53 points for classes VI to IX and B2 in Co-Scholastic subjects for class XI. For class IX, point will be calculated without upgradation.*

## **100% ATTENDANCE**

*Student(s) attending the class from the first day of the academic session to the last day of the Evaluation-3/Summative II/ Annual Examination will be eligible for the 100% Attendance Award.*

- *If the student has attended all the official working days of the school then he/she will be eligible for this award.*
- *The student must attend the classes from the first day of the academic session.*
- *If a student goes home in between then, attendance will be not be marked for the day. He /she will not be considered for merit purpose.*

## **SCHOLAR GOWN & GOLD MEDAL**

*A student securing a Scholar Badge for three consecutive academic sessions shall become eligible for a Scholar's Gown and if it is for six consecutive sessions, for a Gold Medal.*

## **GOOD CHIT**

*In order to boost the morale of the student, a Good Chit is awarded to all those students who excel or show improved performance in a particular subject.*

## **CRITERIA FOR SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS**

*In order to become eligible for Special Achievement Award, a child has to participate in National level competitions, examinations, NCC(RDC), Scout and Guide Camps, Sports and Games and activities organised by reputed government-recognized national bodies or institutions like – CBSE, DPS Society, NCERT, Olympiad Foundation, SCERT, SGFI etc.*

*The child will be awarded points in a given academic session according to the following criteria. The points listed below will be applicable for those participants (individual or team) permitted (written permission only) by the School authority to participate in competition(s) at various levels. However points will not be awarded if a child secures positions in outside competitions without prior intimation from the school authority.*

### ***Awarded points will not be a matter of right but a matter of merit***

- 1. 20 points will be awarded if a student secures top 3 positions and wins awards at the National level (SGFI, National Meets, DPS National Meet, CBSE National Meet, NTSE, Brahm Prakash Memorial Quiz, RDC, Rajya Puraskar, KVPY, DIST – Inspire Science Camp, National Board of Higher Mathematics, NCERT, and NSO.*
- 2. 14 points will be awarded if he / she represents the school at National level but does not win any prize and top 3 positions in State level competitions.*
- 3. 10 points if he /she secures top 3 positions or wins awards at the DPS / CBSE Zonal level competitions.*
- 4. 06 points if he / she secures top 3 positions at the CBSE Cluster and District level competitions, Annual Training/Coaching Camp like Sports, Games, NCC, Bharat Scouts and Guides, mountaineering, trekking, Excursion, Camp etc.*
- 5. 04 points if he / she secures top 3 positions in competitions held at the local level (like NALCO, CISF, HAL, PARAB-any sort of exhibition organised by local agencies).*

6. 02 points if he/she participates in CBSE Cluster and District level Competitions like Annual Training/Coaching Camp like Sports, Games, NCC, Bharat Scouts and Guides, mountaineering, trekking, excursion, camp etc.
7. Total points should not exceed 28 in case of internal competitions and 56 in case of external competitions for individual and team events.
8. Final external points will be added for overall championship.
9. There will be no topper in Class X. If any organisation requires the topper then the Scholastic and Co-Scholastic criteria will be followed as for other classes like IX (as per CBSE norms).

All the above-mentioned points from Sl.No. 1-6 will be considered after the student produces document(s)/ certificate(s) or any authentic written proof (photocopy) which is to be submitted to the Class Teacher. The original documents will be produced during verification and consideration by the competent authority.
