WALK - IN - INTERVIEW

Delhi Public School Damanjodi run by Delhi Public School Society, New Delhi in collaboration with National Aluminium Company Limited invites candidates for the following posts purely on Temporary basis till 31st March 2026:-

General Instructions:

- ➤ The appointment is purely on temporary basis for a period upto 31st March 2026. During this period, the candidates will be paid a consolidated salary of Rs. 45,000/- per month for the post of PGT (Accountancy) and Rs. 35,400/-per month for the post of PRT (Social Science).
- ➤ The candidates will not make any claim as a permanent employee of the institution in future, after completion of the term of their service.
- > To go ahead with the selection process in a subject, at least three (03) eligible applicants should be available for the Written Test.
- > The Management reserves the right to cancel the recruitment process without issuing any further notice or assigning any reason thereto, if it is felt so on valid grounds.

General Guidelines for the candidates:-

- \triangleright Maximum age limit for the post of PRT 35 years and PGT 40 years (As on 01/06/2025).
- > The candidates without having the necessary qualifications and marks need not report / attend the interview.



- The Walk-In-Interview is scheduled to be held on 14th June 2025 in the school premises from 10:00 am onwards.
- Interested candidates can attend the **Walk-in-interview** at the aforesaid venue by 9:30 am alongwith bio-data and all the original Mark Sheets / Certificates as well as self-attested photocopies of the same and a passport-sized photograph.
- ➤ However any candidate securing less than 50% Marks at any stage of his / her academic career (i.e. class X/XII/Graduation/Post Graduation) will not be considered for appearing the interview.
- Recruitment process will start with Screening of the Application Forms. Written Test carries 70 Marks (including Current Affairs, General English and Concerned Subject).
- > The candidate should bring black / blue ball point pen with them for the Written Test.
- After the Written Test, the short-listed candidates will be required to proceed for a Demo Class followed by the Personal Interview.
- Preference will be given to the highly experienced candidates having excellent command over written and spoken English, bright academic record with first class throughout, Public School background and ability to teach at least two subjects. Demonstrated interest in co-curricular activities will have distinct advantage.
- ➤ If wrong information is furnished and it is noticed at a later stage during the service, services of such candidate(s) will be terminated and appropriate disciplinary action will be initiated against such candidates.
- > Temporary teacher, if appointed shall maintain absolute integrity towards his/her profession and justify his/her services. The students must be benefitted with classroom transaction/any allied academic activity.
- ➤ He /She should take utmost care of students under his/her care, as the safety and security of the students is of paramount importance. He/she should not resort to corporal punishment. He/she should maintain himself/herself in such a way as the society expects from a teacher. He/she should follow the Code of Conduct for Teachers as per CBSE guidelines.
- Example 2 Candidates if selected are advised not to request for extension of joining date. They will get ten (10) days' time to produce the NOC (if applicable), if not submitted beforehand or at the time of joining the duty.
- > Temporary teaching staff will not be paid for the summer vacation, if the situation arises so / service breaks. They are not entitled to other service benefits, like EL / LTC / Puja Advance / Uniform allowance etc. However, the provisions applicable for the Temporary teachers will be followed by the school.
- ➤ No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the interview.
